North Berwick Environment Trust in collaboration with the British Divers Marine Life Rescue Charity is holding a talk in La Gaiete Spiegeltent on Sunday 14th August, North Berwick Harbour at 12noon.



Dr Mark Dalgleish will be talking about his work in studying the causes of mass strandings of whales and dolphins. The BDMLR will be demonstrating how they rescue such animals with the help of some lifesize inflatable whales, dolphins and seals on the beach at 11am and 1pm.

Want to Change the World? Free course starting in Dunbar



What: Taster Session for U.Lab

When: Thursday 18th August, 7.8.30pm **Where**: Bleachingfield Centre, Dunbar

East Lothian residents are invited to take part in a free 8-week course on changing the world. Known as U.Lab, the course is a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC). Last year thousands of people around the world participated, including hundreds in Scotland. It is hoped that Dunbar can be a "hub" for people from around the area.

The course teaches participants how to respond to many changes and disruptions in the world, from inequality to climate change. It helps participants to find ways to make change in themselves, their communities and society in order to change the world. The course was developed in the United States at MIT and now draws in thousands of participants from 182 countries.

Local activists Elisabeth Wilson and Chris Bruce undertook the course last year and are offering a free "taster session" at the Bleachingfield Centre in Dunbar on Thursday 18th August from 7pm to 8.30pm. The hub is being supported locally by Sustaining Dunbar, a development trust, and the first of eight sessions starts on Thursday 8 September.


This consultation started at the "Live from Lewisvale" event on the 31st July and will continue until midnight on Sunday 21st August 2016.

BT Payphone Removal Consultations

BT has been undertaking extensive research to identify public payphones that are no longer viable to keep. There are currently 36 public payphones in East Lothian which have been identified and proposed for removal by BT under the 90-day consultation process, although this number may be subject to minor change as the removal notices are physically posted.

Through our Adopt a Kiosk scheme; communities will also have the opportunity to adopt any phone box for just £1. The traditional, red phone boxes are part of our heritage and by opening them up for adoption; your community can keep these iconic landmarks and put them to great use. Uses made of phone boxes already adopted include a grocery shop, a wildlife information centre and the Community Heartbeat Trust charity has even installed defibrillators in some boxes.
