This web address will divert seamlessly to our new customised home page on "The List".

The List is a nationwide events database and is based in Edinburgh. As part of our contract with them, they have agreed to accept all East Lothian events whether large or small, provided all new postings are made via the whatsoneastlothian home page. They will moderate all postings on our behalf, so there are no ongoing maintenance or administration tasks for us to do. New postings take about 3 days before being cleared by a moderator on The List. This service is entirely free to the user. Our home page is scaleable, and will adjust automatically to the screen size whether viewed on a PC or a smartphone. It is essential that all event organisers in the County are encouraged to post their events here. In that way, whatsoneastlothian.com will become a one-stop shop for all events in the County, for both locals and visitors.


Using the site is intuitive, however, there is a youtube video which explains step by step how to use the site both for searches and for new postings.

We are delighted that our project, the creation of a 'Woodland Learning Zone', will receive funding from the Tesco 'Bags of Help' scheme!

The purpose of the Woodland Learning Zone is to facilitate natural play and learning in a woodland setting. We will be working with the East Lothian Council Ranger Service to ensure the area is as wildlife friendly as possible.

The public will now vote in store from 26 September to 9 October on who should receive the £12,000, £10,000 and £8,000 awards. How much Cuthill Park receives is up to the voters at Musselburgh Tesco!

£8,000 worth of funding could pay for:

- Story circle seating
- A Storytelling Chair
- **Interpretation Boards**
- **Fairy Doors and Windows**

£10,000 worth of funding could also commission a bespoke entrance way to the Woodland Learning Zone. Can you imagine how exciting that would be for young visitors to the park?!

£12,000 (the top award) would enable us to purchase and install a sculpture within the woodland area.

Volunteers have already worked hard to prepare the groundwork for this project - we are so excited that it is finally going to happen!

This would enable us to supply equipment and coaching support to venues all over East Lothian including community centres and sheltered housing. At this stage we are looking to gather information on the venues that could accommodate regular play so that we are able to build a strong case. As an example, I attended the over 60s group in Longniddry this week. They have 16 members, most I suspect over 70. They currently play on 2 tables, stopping for tea and cake mid-session. It was great with lots of chat, laughter and some big hits too. They would be interested in having at least one extra table, possible two to allow more people to join in. It's just the sort of group that could get started in every community centre and village hall with a bit of support.
