Message from David Small, Director Health & Social Care Partnership:

I'm delighted to let you know that initial construction work on the new East Lothian Community Hospital will start this October. This news comes after financial contracts for the new building were signed with the Scottish Government and our partners on the project, Hub South East Scotland Ltd. I am thrilled that the new hospital is now a reality. I would like to thank those of you who have joined us at events as your input has supported in getting the project to this stage, the project team in particular has done a fantastic job and we can now look ahead with great anticipation to the new hospital opening in 2020.

The community hospital will make a huge difference to how and where people in the county are treated. It will mean more patients are treated closer to their homes and it will bring with it a big increase in inpatients beds. Our current ageing facilities at Roodlands and Herdmanflat will be transformed within the new building. Meaning closer and more joined up working between staff and services and bringing an improved experience for all of our patients.

The first phase of works will see the outpatient department and combined endoscopy/surgery suite developed and works will start on this in the next few weeks. We will keep you updated on a regular basis via flyer or newsletter and on occasion hold further events




