Security of property in East Linton	Report from Dunpender CC representative that numerous East Linton residents are complacent with security – open garages, unlocked bikes on front gardens etc. Posters to be displayed on community notice boards and shops encouraging people to lock up their property. Festive holidays Anti Social Behaviour	Conduct evening patrols dealing with youth behaviour, preventing alcohol consumption, related ASB and associated dangers and later conducting dispersal patrols at licensed premises.	Dunbar Community Policing Team
Link in with ELC regarding various road safety issues associated with the growth of the town.	Various roads, particularly to the south of Belhaven and West Barns, have greatly increased traffic volumes.
