ASB in vennels off Dunbar High Street	Following complaint received from resident regarding noise, littering and urinating in closes patrols, engagement and enforcement to be conducted.	Dunbar Community Policing Team
Volume of lorries travelling through East Linton and narrow country lanes	Large volume of lorries travelling through East Linton and Markle moving soil from Dunbar house building sites. Link in with site managers to ascertain if alternative more suitable routes are possible.	Dunbar Community Policing Team

### **Update on priorities:**

#### **Parking obstruction outside licensed premises**

Staff at premises in West Barns and East Linton spoken to regarding obstructions caused by parking associated to their premises. Situation monitored since then and noticeable improvement.

#### **ASB in vennels off Dunbar High Street**

No calls regarding youth related ASB on Dunbar High Street. Youths taken to congregating at clearing in Lochend Woods. Numerous calls initially regarding concerns about bonfires but youths now instructed not to have bonfires and no calls to police since then.

#### **Volume of lorries travelling through East Linton and narrow country lanes**

Site manager for ground works at Cala site by Beveridge Row spoken to. Following concerns he was already aware of the lorries have been re-routed.

**Other ongoing policing issues:**

-200 youths at Bullet Hill Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> June. One female arrested for assault, no other issues reported.

-Talks given to all S3's by PC Ross, P7's by PC Johnston (School link officer) and P6's by Community Warden Jimmy Wilson.
