POLICE REPORT

ONGOING ISSUES:

- Speeding:** The Police are aware of speeding in both Stenton and Innerwick. Residents are asked to report speeding vehicles by calling 101, and also to be aware of their own speed in our rural communities.
- Hare Coursing:** Hare coursing continues to be an issue in all rural areas of East Lothian. It is illegal to hunt hares using dogs under the Protection of Wild Mammals (Scotland) Act 2002 and anyone found to be doing so can expect to be prosecuted. Should you witness hare coursing, please phone the police immediately on 101.
- Home Security:** Police ask for vigilance and for residents to ensure homes, garages and outbuildings are secured.
