### **Speeding in 20mph trial zones**

Speed checks conducted at both location on the afternoon of Friday 19<sup>th</sup> October.

Browns Place, East Linton: 20 vehicles had their speeds checked, 5 stopped and issued warnings, 1 stopped and issued fixed penalty ticket for doing 31 mph.

Queens Road: 15 vehicles had their speeds checked, 5 stopped and issued warnings, 1 stopped and charged for doing 35mph and will be reported to the procurator fiscal.

It is our intention to conduct a further speed check this afternoon prior to the meeting.
